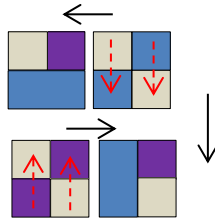


# Courtyard—Mystery Quilt October 2016

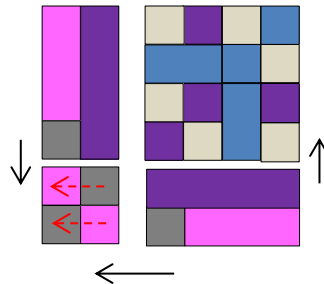
## Clue 6: Putting the Blocks Together!

1. Using the units you pieced in Clues 3-5, arrange and sew a sub-block as shown below; the 4-Patches should be turned so the final seam you pressed is oriented as shown by the red dashed arrows.



This unit should measure 8-1/2" square. Complete 24 of these units.

2. Arrange and sew the Pink/Purple strips and Pink 4-Patches to the units from Step #1 as shown, turning the 4-Patch so the final seam you pressed is oriented as shown by the red dashed arrows. Press seams in the directions indicated by the black arrows. Complete 24 of these units, which should measure 12-1/2" square.
