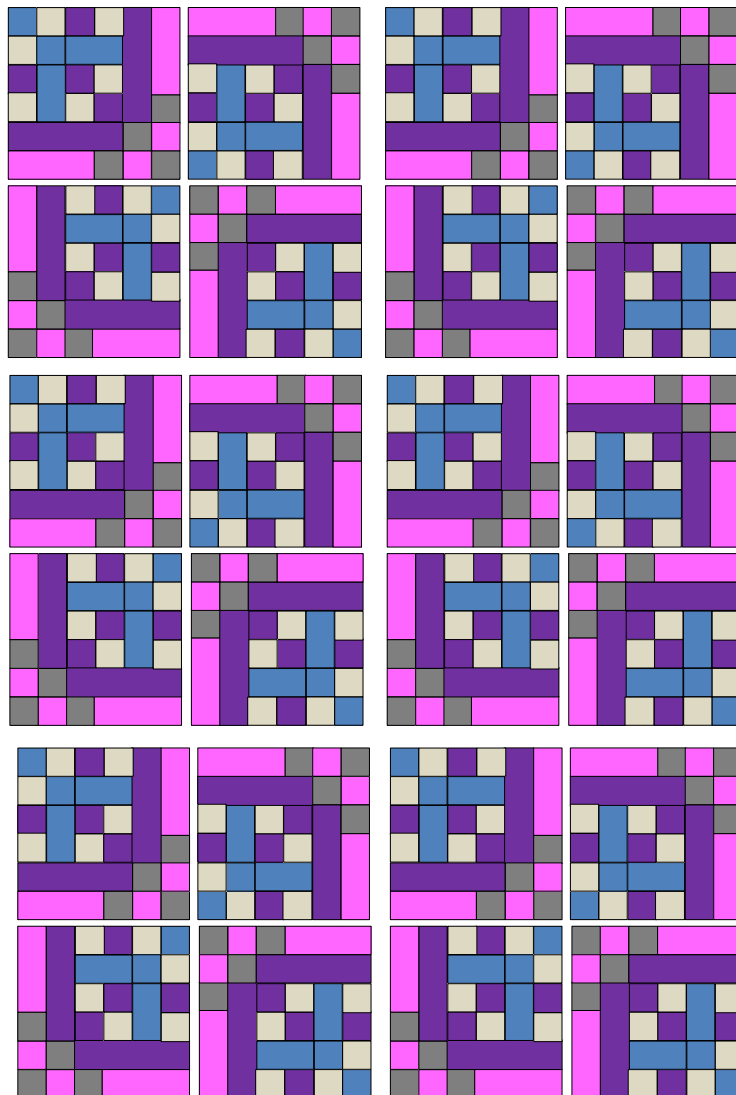


Courtyard—Mystery Quilt October 2016

Clue 7: Putting the Quilt Top Together

Now we're going to rotate and place the blocks, and sew them into a top. The seams should all be pressed so they "nest" up against the seam next to them.

Paying careful attention to the orientation of each block, arrange and sew the blocks into 6 rows of 4 blocks each, as shown below. (To keep from getting confused, or my eyeballs rotating around in my head, I follow the direction the Blue "arrow" is pointing in each block.) Every 2 x 2 block section repeats.



Now all that's left is the shouting! Well, and the border....
