
Courtyard—Mystery Quilt October 2016

Clue 8: Border

We'll be adding a 3" border all around. Mine is going to be purple, because I like purple.



- 1. Sew 2 of the 3-1/2" Border strips to form a long (approx. 80") strip; repeat with another pair of strips.
- 2. Cut one of the remaining strips in half and sew one of the halves to a remaining full strip to form a strip approx. 60" long; repeat with remaining half and full strip.
- 3. Measure the length of the quilt (measure in the center), cut the 80" strips to that length and sew one to each long side of the quilt. Press seams toward the border.
- 4. Measure the width of the quilt (again, measuring in the center), cut the 60" strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt.

NOW all that's left is the shouting. After the quilting and binding, of course.
