

Spinners Mystery Quilt

Clue 2: Cutting

Blue:

- (8) strips 3-1/2" x WOF; subcut EACH into (3) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- (1) strip 4" x WOF; subcut into (10) 4" squares
- (1) strip 4" x WOF; from this subcut:
 - (2) 4" squares (Add to stack of previously cut 4" squares)
 - (2) 3-1/2" squares
- (2) 3-1/2" x WOF; subcut EACH into: (11) 3-1/2" squares, for a total of 22
(Add these to the Blue 3-1/2" squares cut previously.)

Red:

- (8) 3-1/2" x WOF; subcut EACH into (3) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- (1) 4" x WOF; subcut into (10) 4" squares
- (1) 4" x WOF; subcut into:
 - (2) 4" squares (Add to stack of previously cut Red 4" squares)
 - (2) 3-1/2" squares
- (2) 3-1/2" x WOF; subcut EACH into (11) 3-1/2" squares
(Add these to the Red 3-1/2" squares cut previously)

White:

- (16) 3-1/2" x WOF; subcut EACH:
 - (3) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2"
 - (3) 3-1/2" squares
- (2) 3-1/2" x WOF; subcut EACH into (11) 3-1/2" squares.
- (3) 4" x WOF; subcut EACH:
 - (8) 4" squares
 - (1) 3-1/2" square

Inner Border:

- (7) 1-1/2" x WOF

Outer Border:

- (7) 3-1/2" x WOF



So, when all is said and done, you will have:

Blue:

(24) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2"

(12) 4" squares

(24) 3-1/2" squares

Red:

(24) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2"

(12) 4" squares

(24) 3-1/2" squares

White:

(48) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2"

(72) 3-1/2" squares

(24) 4" squares

Inner Border: (7) 1-1/2" x WOF

Outer Border: (7) 3-1/2" x WOF
