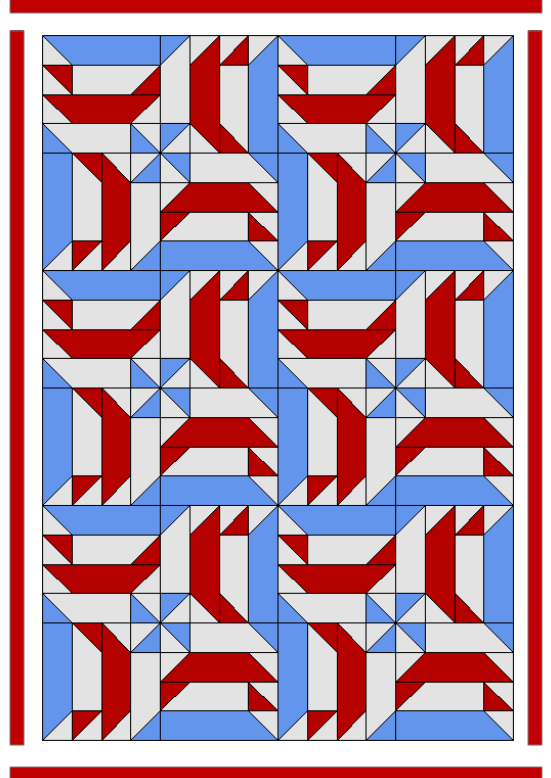


Spinners Mystery Quilt

Clue 8: Borders

Inner Border:

1. Sew 2 of the 1-1/2" Inner Border strips to form a long (approx. 80") strip; repeat with another pair of strips.
2. Cut one of the remaining strips in half and sew one of the halves to a remaining full strip to form a strip approx. 60" long; repeat with remaining half and full strip.
3. Measure the length of the quilt (measure in the center), cut the 80" strips to that length and sew one to each long side of the quilt. Press seams toward the border.
4. Measure the width of the quilt (again, measuring in the center), cut the 60" strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border strips.



Outer Border

1. Sew 2 of the 3-1/2" Outer Border strips to form a long (approx. 80") strip; repeat with another pair of strips.
2. Cut one of the remaining strips in half and sew one of the halves to a remaining full strip to form a strip approx. 60" long; repeat with remaining half and full strip.
3. Measure the length of the quilt (measure in the center), cut the 80" strips to that length and sew one to each long side of the quilt. Press seams toward the border.
4. Measure the width of the quilt (again, measuring in the center), cut the 60" strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt.
