



## Three Up

**This block is a modified 9-patch that doesn't *quite* look like a 9-patch. It's almost like a rail fence, but doesn't *quite* look like a rail fence.**

**Here's how to make the block:**

1. Starting with the center third of the block, piece together strips about 4" long together to form a strip at least 9-1/2" long. Use strips of varied widths, and use medium and dark strips. Straighten the edges to make a strip that is 3-1/2" x 9-1/2"



2. Cut two 3-1/2" squares from medium and dark fabrics. Cut two 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles from scraps of light fabric.



3. Sew a 3-1/2" square to the end of a 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle; repeat with another square and rectangle.

4. Arrange the pieces as shown below. Then arrange block as you like, rotating blocks to form pattern.
