

Snowball Fight

Mug Rug



Background fabric:

- 6-1/2" square
- (8) 1-1/2" squares

White

- 2" x 4" strip (mitten cuff)
- (2) 3-1/2" squares (snowballs)

Mitten fabric: 6" square

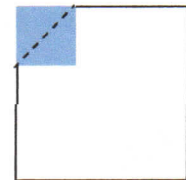
Fusible web: 8" square

1. Trace mitten and cuff onto smooth side of fusible web. Rough cut around them, and fuse the mitten shape to the wrong side of the mitten fabric, and the cuff shape to the wrong side of the 2" x 4" white strip. (Follow the manufacturer's instructions for the fusible web.)

2. Cut the mitten and cuff shapes on drawn lines, remove the paper backing and arrange them, centered, on the 6-1/2' background square. (The top of the cuff will overlap the bottom of the mitten slightly.) Fuse.

Draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the wrong side of the 8 background squares.

3. Place a background square in one corner of a 3-1/2" white square, making sure the drawn line is oriented as shown. Sew on the drawn line.



4. Fold back the background square to make a triangular corner. Press. (Trim the excess background and corner square fabric, if you wish.)

5. Repeat with the remaining background squares on the other 3 corners of the square, and the four corners of the other 3-1/2' square..

6. Sew the two snowball squares together with a scant 1/4" seam. Press seam open, or to one side, as you wish. Sew the snowball section to the mitten section, on the side with the mitten thumb. Press seam open, or to one side.

Layer, quilt, and bind.
